Madrid is presenting the city's candidacy for World Capital of Sport 2022, a project that seeks to put our city on the map of sports worldwide.

Madrid is an open, diverse and cosmopolitan city, capable of hosting and organising major sports events that add up to more than 250 events each season and that make the capital a benchmark for modernity, activity and safety, offering, as it does, every guarantee for the practice of risk-free sports thanks to its facilities, accumulated experience and the implementation of physical exercise and health protocols.

At this time, and as a result of the pandemic, Madrid has reinforced safety in its sports centres and throughout the entire city, making every effort with preventive measures against COVID 19 to ensure that a stay in the city does not pose any danger to health and that it remains a friendly place which has room for everyone.

In addition, we mustn't forget its rich cultural and natural heritage, the second city in the world in green areas; its modern infrastructures and facilities, and the desire of all public agencies to make these increasingly accessible, within the objective of creating inclusive architecture. At the same time, Madrid stands out for its extensive network of city buses, trains, and underground Metro system: the fourth largest in the world. Along with this, the city has also moved decisively towards sustainable urban mobility over the last decade.

For all these reasons, Madrid is the ideal city to be the World Capital of Sport in 2022, as it boasts not only the commitment and support of this city council, but also that of the rest of public bodies and sports organisations and federations and, especially, with the support of the people of Madrid, the main players in the sport and life of the city.



Madrid is presenting its candidacy to become "World Capital of Sport 2022" through this comprehensive document, which includes: all the information on the city's vast municipal sports infrastructure, the diversity of services and activities, the significant annual calendar of major international events and, in general, a whole host of data on sport in Madrid that details the great efforts that we are currently making and that give solid backing to our candidacy.

Sport and physical activity are also about health, fun, social integration, coexistence, unity and teamwork, helping to fight racism and violence, as well as promoting equality and peace.



Plan for developing sports in the city. Objectives


The Madrid City Council currently has a Strategic Sports Plan in place with a validity established for the 2013–2020 period.

After these 7 years, in view of the evolution experienced by sports at the municipal level, and growing citizen response regarding the practice of physical exercise, it is considered timely and absolutely necessary to address the work for the preparation and approval of a new plan, in order to determine the city's strategic lines with regard to sport for the next 15 years.

The purpose of this is to adapt the changing and constantly evolving reality that is the sports and physical activity sector, to the new needs of the Madrid population and to the Council's objectives: to promote sport as a source of

health and well-being, to support and consolidate women's sports, to promote inclusive sports, minority sports, to support and promote children's and youth grassroots sports, to expand outdoor exercise, pay special attention to programmes for the elderly, to build and manage new facilities in a collaborative public-private regime, to provide new spaces for sports, integrate new technologies in sports services, etc...

The 2021 Budget includes the credit required to start said planning works, and the intention is for the aforementioned Plan to be in force for the period 2021–2036.



Access to sports facilities and activities

Operation of the city's clubs. Agreements, subsidies and use of facilities

Sports associations in Madrid

The Law on Sports of the Community of Madrid defines the figure of sports associations within the scope of private sports organisations.

Madrid sports associations have, in turn, different figures, namely: clubs, regional club groups, sports groups, sports action sections, neighbourhood sports coordinators, sports federations of the Community of Madrid and associations of sports federations.

The most widespread and influential figure in the city of Madrid are sports clubs, defined as:

Private associations, made up of natural or legal persons whose objective is the promotion of one or more sports disciplines, the practice of such sports by their members, and participation in sports activities and competitions.

Collaboration between sports associations and the Area for Sport of the Madrid City Council

Within the sports service offered by the Delegated Area for Sport of the Madrid City Council, sports associations are essential to be able to provide a quality service adapted to the context of each municipal district.

The sports service of the Madrid City Council, in relation to the participation of the Madrid sports associative networks, is structured as follows:



Mutual collaboration of sports associations with the Area for Sport of the Madrid City Council, in relation to the sports service offer

Collaborative Municipal Sports Schools Programme

Within the sports lessons and schools, in municipal sports centres, along with the teaching activity managed by in-house staff for the development of certain disciplines, we find the so-called "Collaborative Sports Schools" for children and young people aged between 6 and 17 years, as a general rule, and activities for people with disabilities. These operate from September to June, inclusive.

Collaboration agreements are signed for these schools, selecting the collaborating bodies from among those whose corporate purpose is the promotion and advancement of sports. The bodies provide certified and qualified sports coaches to teach the agreed sessions, as well as the technical management of the school, which must be supervised by the sports director of the sports centre (own staff of the Madrid City Council). The Madrid City Council pays part of the costs for the implementation of each school, expenses that include the initial start-up and expenses relating to technical management and teaching of sports.

In 2019, a total of 104 agreements were signed with 91 Madrid sports bodies, with a total offer of 12,452 places and the budget allocated for this in 2020 amounted to €1,879,725.40.

Municipal Schools programme for the promotion of sports

The programme "Municipal Schools for the promotion of sports" is developed in nursery and primary schools with the basic objective of promoting the practice of sports among the school population, especially with regard to relatively uncommon disciplines, with the intention of optimising the use of sports facilities in schools, promoting sports associations in schools and fostering the identification of talent in young athletes.

The programme runs from 1 October of one year to 30 June of the following year. During the 2018/2019 season, the programmes were developed in 213 centres, with 443 municipal schools for the promotion of sports (MSPS) in educational centres and a total of 589 groups, with 8,820 participants (3,338 women), whose evolution in recent years is shown in the table attached: It should be noted that the Programme offers sports services in 181 public schools, and 32 publicly-funded private schools, in 18 sports disciplines.

Agreements are signed with 18 Madrid Sports Federations.

The 2020 budget for this programme amounted to €1,276,000.00.

Other programmes

In addition to the two major programmes mentioned above, the list of sports services includes other sports programmes, which depend largely on collaboration with the Madrid sports associations:

- Municipal Sports Classrooms, a programme aimed at education centres in sports facilities outside schools, through agreements with 7 sports bodies and with a total participation in 2019 of 15,745 students.
- Sports programmes to promote gender equality and the participation of groups at risk of social exclusion. Self-defence workshops for women (1,742 places offered in 2019) and programmes for groups at risk of social exclusion (566 places offered in 2019). For these programmes, agreements were signed with 3 sports bodies, with a budget of €118,390 allocated in 2020.

Accessibility of sports bodies to sports facilities dependant on the Madrid City Council

When talking about access to municipal sports facilities, three types of facilities must be considered, in accordance with Regulations on the Use of Sports Facilities and Services:

Municipal Sports Centres (MSC).

Basic Sports Facilities (BSF) with controlled access.

Municipal sports facilities with free access.

According to the 2019 report from the Area for Sport, the city of Madrid has a total of 74 Municipal Sports Centres and 501 Basic Sports Facilities, 101 with controlled access and 400 Basic Sports Facilities with free access.

User accessibility to Madrid's municipal sports facilities (MSC and BSF) with controlled access, is regulated by an Ordinance on public prices that is updated every year and ultimately revolves around users and individual access. The last modification of the current Ordinance is dated 23 December 2019. However, associations play a key role in regulating access to facilities:

- MSC. With regard to access to MSCs, in addition to the majority of rates applied to individual users, there is a type of rate called "Assignment of sports spaces for training". This rate is aimed at federated sports bodies and sports bodies that participate in the competition programmes of the Area for Sport of the Madrid City Council.

These assignments are arranged during the end of the season, prior to the applicable season (September to June). Prices are practically symbolic, as one hour of training a week, depending on the type of installation, ranges from 5 to 42 Euro per user, depending on the age group, made in a single payment for the entire season. A club, as a sporting body, can have this assignment reserved free of charge.

- BSF. In the Madrid City Council, the management of BSF with controlled access is usually assigned to sports bodies through competitive public tenders, which can be accessed by any solvent organisation with registered address in the corresponding municipal district.

Subsidies:

In 2020, the Madrid City Council allocated subsidies amounting to €4,950,124.08 to sports bodies for the development of sports and competition activities, and to clubs with teams in non-professional national leagues during the 2018/2019 season, in addition to publishing two extraordinary subsidies, for the maintenance of sports and competition activities, as well as for financing sports events in the city, in the 2019–2020 season, affected by the Covid-19 pandemic

Accessibility to facilities: price reductions, sports passes and transport

As indicated in the previous point, there is a municipal ordinance that regulates public prices for access to municipal sports services. This Ordinance is regulated and modified regularly and includes different price reductions for different groups:

Progressive criterion. Progressive pricing is the main criterion used in the regulation of municipal sports service prices, which is detailed below, ordered by level of price reduction. The price reduction depends on each rate, never being free of charge:



- Elderly, aged 65 or over.
- Children, up to 14 years.
- Youth, 15 to 26 years.
- Adults, 27 to 64 years.

Family criteria. There are price reductions for large families and single-parent families.

Health criteria. There are programmes with reductions for people with pathologies who are referred to the sports service by their doctors.

Social criteria:

- Unemployed people (may benefit from a reduction of up to 70%).
- People in a situation of social exclusion (access may be free of charge).
- People with disabilities (access may be free of charge).
- Certain professional groups (local or national security forces, and soon, healthcare staff).
- High-level Athletes (HLA), soon.



03 Club participation in leagues




Volunteers for Sport

The Madrid City Council has a volunteer service 'Voluntarios por Madrid', coordinated by the Family, Equality and Social Welfare Government Area.

In addition, every time the city hosts a major international or national sports event, citizen participation is huge.

An example of this is the Madrid Popular Marathon, which brings together almost 40,000 athletes, and the UEFA Champions League and Copa Libertadores finals, both held in Madrid in 2019.

Another example is the experience of the three Olympic candidacies presented by the city before the International Olympic Committee, in which thousands of Madrid citizens signed up as volunteers, including, for instance, 134,100 volunteers for the Madrid 2020 candidacy.

Analysis of Return on Investment in the organisation of sports events

The Madrid City Council, through the Government Area for Culture, Tourism and Sport, by virtue of the provisions of the Agreement of the Government Board of the City of Madrid of 4 July 2019, which establishes the organisation and powers of the aforementioned Area, develops sports promotion programmes, coordinates and collaborates in the organisation of **sports events** that are held in the City of Madrid, and promotes the city of Madrid abroad through sports events.

The Strategic Plan for Grassroots Sports in Madrid 2013–2020 approved by the Governing Board of the City of Madrid, by Agreement dated 27 November, 2013, establishes as a mission, the promotion and advancement of sports activities among Madrid citizens, pointing out among its objectives the support of initiatives that **encourage the promotion of sport, and capitalise on the potential of sport as a sector of economic activity and an element for international projection and promotion.**

Likewise, the Delegated Area for Sport, in accordance with its budgetary objectives, includes as one of its objectives the **empowerment of Madrid as an organiser of major sports events through sponsorship.**

For this reason, one of the key strategic axes of the Delegated Area is the **sponsorship of sports events** not only to support sport, but also to promote the city of Madrid through these events, as a host city for sports, as a support for healthy living and as a projection of the city of Madrid, with the corresponding economic returns and brand enhancement that the celebration of these events entails.

Most of these events, which are carried out through sponsorship contracts, are held with the sports federations authorised to carry out said events, or in public-private collaboration with private sector bodies whose corporate purpose includes sports and cultural events, recreational activities, and PR activities in the sector of organising events and tournaments.

This collaboration is based on **four key environments** aligned with the strategy of this Delegated Area:

1-Relevance of event for the city of Madrid

Sports events can contribute greatly to a city's development, given that the attraction for sports is wide-ranging, from the love of exercise, to the excitement of following championships and events, which become authentic social phenomena. In certain situations, these even change the appearance of a city, as in the case of the quintessential global event – the Olympic Games.

These types of events have the particular feature, for the benefit of the host city, of attracting huge crowds and of creating a deep-rooted tradition and great power of identification with the host city.

The celebration of these events is currently understood as a source of returns through direct benefits on the economy, the community, and external projection. That is why one of the priority objectives of this Area is to develop sponsorship actions carried out in the past, over the coming years, something which has been reflected both in the Government Operation Plan and in the Strategic Map with the following commitments: "to attract new sports events and recover the Olympic dream", and "to create a committee of experts" for better diagnosis and assessment of the events to be sponsored for the benefit of sport, and for the benefit of promoting the city of Madrid.

Based on the assessment made of the sporting events held in the city of Madrid, the following returns have been identified:

- They place the city of Madrid at the global level in the support of sport.
- They are an excellent vehicle to publicise and disseminate the promotion of sport and an excellent platform to promote the values of sport and healthy habits.
- They offer excellent opportunities for international projection and positioning of Madrid as a city that supports sport.
- They involve significant brand impact in media for the city of Madrid, through advertising returns from the publicity of the event.
- They involve an economic and social impact for the city, resulting in economic benefits for Madrid, mainly in the service sector.

2-Commitment to Sport

Sport, whatever the discipline, is a primary indicator in establishing and measuring the improvement in the quality of life of a society and a population. Madrid is one of the cities with the largest number of sports facilities, whose decentralised management is carried out at district level, complemented by the transversal sports service actions carried out by the Delegated Area, which is naturally the Area's main competence, as reflected in the Government Council Agreement of 4 July 2019, section 11, 2 "develop the sports policy of the Madrid City Council".

For this reason, one of the main returns linked to those described above is the promotion of grassroots sports. This commitment is also reflected in the Government Operation Plan as it has established the inclusion of a clause in all contracts or sponsorship agreements in which the sponsored body is obliged to carry out complementary activities aimed at grassroots sports.

This is a newly incorporated return and one that this Delegated Area has insisted on, compared to previous government teams, making it mandatory for the sponsored body, in order to guarantee not only the economic and publicity



return, but also a direct impact on grassroots sports from which citizens can benefit directly.

In addition, these sports events place value on the city's sports facilities, and, in many cases, cover their initial cost.

Thus, our sponsors this year have been required to provide consistent returns in terms of clinics, training videos, big-name visits to sports centres, sports activity in the streets, and similar, bringing direct benefits to the generally most disadvantaged sector of the population, and responding to the specific needs that are deemed most appropriate.

3-Repercussion and dissemination

Viewing sports through sports events not only involves a sports and social component, but also includes the media impact that such events generate and that result in the promotion of the city nationally and internationally, depending on the event's characteristics.

They have a great impact on tourist returns, we can even talk about sports tourism, as these events are identified with the host cities, and are an incentive to visit them.

For this reason, in the prior studies carried out to assess sponsorships, both the economic returns for the city of Madrid and the media returns are taken into consideration

Among the economic aspects, it is worth highlighting the average expenditure of each visitor, whether they are from the same locality or a different place, Spanish or foreign, and such expenditure includes meal and accommodation expenses, transport, hospitality, tickets, and shopping.

Also, the economic return is highly relevant when considering the services and supplies to be contracted for the actual organisation of the event, making use of Madrid's extensive and qualified service network for the assembly and installation of infrastructures, and the provision of all kinds of services. Sometimes we also have to consider the possibility of returns 'in kind' from temporary, ephemeral or permanent infrastructures.

Finally, there is another highly significant return to be considered, that affects the city's wealth through direct and indirect taxes, payment of fees and public rates, resulting from the services, employment contracts and resources to be used in the celebration of the event.

With regard to the media, taking into account today's society and the different media available, both traditional and digital, as well as social networks, brand impact in a sports event multiplies exponentially due to the massive dissemination of these events and their reach in a global society such as ours.

That is why another of the indices monitored and assessed by our Area Communications Department are the possible media returns and subsequent determination of the resources and services which the sponsored body is obliged to provide, on the one hand, and on the other, the resources with which the City Council collaborates, thus uniting the Institutional image with that of the sponsored event at all times. High returns that are difficult to calculate, and are to be estimated by specialist companies in the sector.

Therefore, the returns from the celebration of sports events in the city go beyond the sports and economic benefits, hence the increasing interest of government teams in supporting these initiatives, by making available financial support, administrative management and infrastructure support.

In short, from the diagnosis of the capacity to host these events and their real impacts, we can determine the stable spending, constant and possibly increasing, in the win-win public-private collaboration for these events, which provide a holistic promotion for the city.

Measures to promote health and integration through sport

Health and sports programmes


Comprehensive health areas for personalised attention

Understanding that sports services are health services, and that we are at a turning point in which Physical Activity and especially Physical Exercise, standardised as an instrument for the prevention and improvement of pathologies, is increasingly recognised and demanded, the Madrid City Council is working to integrate and create a multidisciplinary health environment, to optimise services that have already existed for many years, in which Professionals from Physical Exercise and Sports Sciences, Medicine, Nursing, Physiotherapy, Psychology, etc. have been participating.

In addition, the demand by the Government of Madrid (CAM) to collaborate and inspire as a model of local council involvement in the creation and design of the Strategy for “Prescription and Intervention – Exercise Prescription” that will be implemented in the Madrid Health Services of the Community of Madrid, make this model the reference point for multidisciplinary physical exercise and health services that are to be created in other smaller municipalities.

Objective:

- Integrate infrastructures, as well as optimise the use of these spaces by all professionals mentioned above: Professionals from Physical Exercise and Sports Sciences, Medicine, Nursing, Physiotherapy, Psychology, etc. without prejudice to the reservations that each profession may impose for its development.
- Converge all the material and human resources relating to medical-sports programmes, with physiotherapy programmes and technical-sports interview programmes and functional assessment of people; as well as those required to carry out necessary consultations to screen citizen demand in relation to the practice of physical exercise and sports for health.



Medical sports Programmes

Developed through the medical, nursing and physiotherapy health staff of the sports medicine services of municipal sports centres:

Objectives:

- Avoid and prevent injuries and physical problems derived from the practice of sports by promoting medical-sports examinations for the practice of sports, whatever the level.
- Determine the indications, contraindications and precautions for the practice of sports.
- Work with sports professionals.
- Develop medical programmes in collaboration with the national health system.

Medical examinations for athletes

Aimed at people who practice any type of physical activity and who want to know if they suffer from any abnormality in the functioning of their body during exercise and what type of activity would be best suited to them to maintain or improve their health.

Cardiovascular Fitness Programme

Aimed at people with health problems: coronary heart disease, myocardial infarction, angina pectoris, high blood pressure, chronic respiratory disease, after long periods of convalescence and inactivity, metabolism disorders, diabetes, obesity, high cholesterol, osteoporosis.

Sports Physiotherapy Programme

Includes a medical assessment of the diagnosis and indications for physiotherapy treatment, which can be carried out in the Sports Medical service of the Municipal Sports Centre.

'Back School' Programme

The ‘Back School’ programme is aimed at people who need complementary exercise techniques, after having been treated in sports centres with physiotherapy centres.

First-aid kits

For the provision of nursing services and care for persons in the event of accidents, heart attacks, treatments, etc.


For the provision of personalised services to people with special needs such as the elderly, people with disabilities, etc., and also for those who are referred by their doctor to a MSC to join a physical exercise programme, either for the treatment of pathologies or for the prevention of chronic diseases because they are part of a population at risk (highly overweight, blood pressure, lipid profile, glucose, etc.).

Objectives:

- Incorporate a multidisciplinary model serviced and developed by technical staff from sports and/or medical areas that responds to the social need of meeting health demands.
- Promote the extension, promotion and advancement of physical activity and the practice of sports, integrating vertically and transversely the sports services offered, emphasising teamwork, coordination between areas and optimisation of available resources.
- Respond in a personalised way to any question or need relating to the practice of sports or to starting any physical activity, so that it is most beneficial and adapted to the person's health and lifestyle.

Quantitative data:

- Quantitative offer: in 39 sports centres from 19 districts
- Sports offer: 386 hours scheduled, 179 in the morning shift and 207 in the afternoon shift.
- Technical Staff: 115 sports technicians, university graduates/ Degrees and/or CAFYDE Graduates (Physical Exercise and Sports Sciences), 61 from the morning shift and 54 from the afternoon shift;
- No. assessments carried out during the season: 9,492
- Period of service: The entire sports season.
- Location: Municipal Sports Centres.



Monitored Physical Exercise and Health Programmes

Aimed at population groups with special needs who through medical prescription or, due to their health or low physical condition, require specific exercising, which in addition to allowing them to participate progressively in the practice of sports, enables them to learn about their capacities and limitations, in order to be able to join the activities of the general programme of lessons and schools, or to work independently in a safe manner.

Objectives:

- Improvement of physical condition and health for inclusion in general programmes
- Obtain the necessary knowledge to be able to carry out physical exercise in a healthy way in relation to one's health.
- Comply with sports-medical prescription.
- Acquire healthy habits.
- Prevent sedentary behaviour.
- Offer alternatives for leisure time.
- Promote social relations, within the framework of respect, solidarity and equality.

Quantitative data:

- General health fitness:
 - Quantitative offer: 1,197 places offered with the participation of 874 persons, of which 78% are women.
 - Sports offer: 2 general categories, not necessarily multi-discipline: Healthy Gymnastics and Healthy Swimming.
 - Period of service: September to June (sports season).
 - Location: Municipal sports centres.
- Activities to promote Healthy Habits:
 - Quantitative offer: 429 places (78% women)
 - Sports offer: multi-discipline categories, with medical-sports prescription or referral report from municipal Community Health Centres:
 - "How to avoid Falls" for the elderly, in 8 sports centres and 9 municipal health centres across 8 districts, with a total of 88 participants.



"Excess weight, Obesity and type 2 Diabetes" in the adult population (1 experience with children), in 12 sports centres and 10 municipal health centres, across 10 districts with a total of 15 groups and 116 participants.

Period of service: September to June (sports season).

Location: Municipal sports centres.

- Specific health fitness programmes:

- Quantitative offer: 1,041 places offered with the participation of 615 persons, of which 87% are women.
- Sports offer: Pregnancy and postpartum programmes and 2 multi-discipline categories with the Municipal Medical-sports Programme Service: cardiovascular fitness and 'Back School'.

Period of service: September to June (sports season).


Location: Municipal sports centres with and without a medical sports service

In addition to the activities mentioned above, there is the possibility of participation through the **inclusion of people with a medical prescription for exercise in standardised groups of the general programme of sports lessons and schools** (including collaborative schools), and special intensive courses, if the condition of **Preferential registration** applies, up to a limited number of places per group, provided that the general requirements corresponding to said group in terms of category, age, level, etc. are met.

Sports for all ages

The Madrid City Council offers in its general programme of lessons and schools, differentiated activities for each age group, in order to promote and encourage the practice of physical activity and sport, and help people acquire the habit of sport, by teaching them the technical aspects of physical exercise, for safe and healthy exercising, and sharing values that affect coexistence, non-discrimination and equality. Incorporating in its design the social inclusion of people with disabilities, the gender perspective and education in values.

In the 2018/2019 season (September to June) a total of 192,653 places were offered in municipal sports centres



01 PRE-SCHOOL ACTIVITIES.

Aimed at girls and boys aged 1 to 5 years. (except in the case of parent-child physical exercise activities, which applies to children aged from 3 months to 4 years;

Places offered: 11,741 places

Sports offer: Swimming, Physical Activity and Games and Pre-sport Activities (of one or more sports disciplines).

02 CHILDREN'S ACTIVITIES

Aimed at children aged 6 to 14.

Places offered: 52,633 places

Sports offer: Sports schools; swimming and other water sports; tennis, padel and other racket sports; karate, judo and other martial arts; and other collective and individual sports; up to a total of 40 sports disciplines.

03 ACTIVITIES YOUNG ADULTS

Aimed at children aged 6 to 14.

Places offered: 52,633 places

Sports offer: Swimming lessons and other water sports; disciplines with musical support, fitness and physical exercise; body-mind; toning; tennis, padel and other racket sports; martial arts; and other collective and individual sports; up to a total of 38 sports disciplines.

04 ACTIVITIES ADULTS AGED 65 AND OVER

Places offered: 106,876 places

Sports offer: Fitness classes, swimming and other water sports; disciplines with musical support, body mind; toning; up to a total of 13 disciplines to maintain the ability to adapt and autonomy in people's daily lives.

Sports programmes for special groups

Specific programme for people with disabilities

For people who, given their type of disability, cannot participate in the programme for lessons and schools, there exists a specific programme, aimed, among other things, at enabling the inclusion of these people in such activities.

Objectives:

- Improve the physical and psychological condition of people with disabilities, contributing to their functional and social autonomy.
- Promote and enable the practice of sports in an environment of effective inclusion and close to their social and family context.
- Offer healthy alternatives for leisure time that reveal new proposals and trends.

- Encourage the capacity for social interaction through the practice of physical-sports activities, thus promoting social cohesion.

For the development of activities, in addition to counting on the technical staff of the Madrid City Council, collaboration agreements are signed with federations and specific sports bodies for people with disabilities, and entities specialising in adapted sports schools for people with physical, intellectual and sensory disabilities.

Quantitative data:

- In the 2018/2019 season, a total of 912 places were offered, and the budget allocated for this in 2020 amounted to €165,400.40

Programme for the Inclusion of people with disabilities in the general programme of lessons and schools

In order to facilitate and extend the practice of sports following the criteria of equality and social inclusion among people with functional diversity, in addition to the specific programme of adapted monitored activities, organisational measures are adopted for inclusion in groups of the general programme of sports lessons and schools and special intensive courses, when the type and level of disability of a person enables their adequate participation in the standard group.

Objectives:

- Enable the practice of sports for people with functional diversity in an inclusive environment and close to their social and family context.
- Improve their physical, intellectual and emotional condition by contributing to their functional autonomy, independence and quality of life.
- Encourage the capacity for social interaction through the practice of physical-sports activities in an inclusive environment, thus promoting social cohesion, raising awareness about differences and placing value on abilities over limitations.

The organisational measures are mainly based on creating special access conditions to facilitate their integration in the practice of sports, on the one hand, in the Preferential Inscription in standardised groups of any programme activity, up to a limited number of places; and on the other, on applying a 70% reduction on the general price of the programmes available.

Quantitative data:

- Offer: in 46 municipal sports centres from 19 districts.
- 70% price reduction in a total of 19,505 monthly payments for people with disabilities, which represent 2,167 fully subsidised places.
- 2,298 people benefiting from a price reduction at some point during the sports season (data obtained taking into account turnover rates).

Programme for people at risk of social exclusion

Aimed at promoting projects of a social and inclusive nature through the practice of sports and protecting the interests of people at risk of exclusion. Sports activities have been programmed for under-represented groups or groups at risk of social exclusion, developed in collaboration with social bodies:

Programmes for the Homeless

Objectives:

- Promote physical and sports activity among the homeless, offering adequate spaces in municipal sports centres.
- Offer the homeless a way to interact with others through physical-sports activities taught by expert technical staff.
- Use municipal services to improve the city's social climate by caring for groups and people who usually do not have access to municipal sports services.
- Offer them the possibility of participating in the different municipal sports services, once basic habits and skills have been acquired, through the Protocol for Social Inclusion of the General Directorate for Sport, thus normalising their participation.
- Complete the community health programmes developed by the Madrid City Council through sport and physical activity.

Quantitative data:

- Quantitative offer: 289 places (253 men and 36 women)
- Sports offer: Physical activity sessions that are available through Municipal Reception Centres.
- Period of service: October to June.
- Location: In 5 municipal sports centres.

Programme for people at risk of addiction or with addictions

Objectives:

- Promote physical and sports activity among drug addicts or people at risk of addiction, offering them adequate spaces in municipal sports centres.
- Offer people at risk of addiction or with addictions a way of social inclusion and of improving their health through physical-sports activities taught by expert technical staff.
- Use municipal services to improve the city's social climate by caring for groups and people who usually do not have access to municipal sports services.
- Offer them the possibility of participating in the different municipal sports services, once basic habits and skills have been acquired, through the different municipal sports programmes and services.
- Complete the community health programmes developed by the Madrid City Council through sport and physical activity.



Quantitative data:

- Quantitative offer: 277 places (139 young people and 138 adults).
- Sports offer: Physical activity sessions that are available through Municipal Centres for the Treatment of Addictions (CTA) of the Madrid Salud Institute of Addictions.
- Period of service: October to June.
- Location: In Municipal sports centres.

WOMEN AND SPORT PROGRAMMES

Programme "Sport makes us #Powerful"

November 2019 saw the presentation of the programme "Sport makes us #Powerful", aimed at promoting the practice of sports in young women between 14 and 24 years old, through the implementation of comprehensive public policies during the 2019–2023 period.


- The programme is exclusively focused on reinforcing grassroots sports.
- Public policy will be aimed at changing the current narrative, which for various reasons alienates or prevents girls and women from practicing sport on a recurring basis.
- The programme has been developed with the collaboration of bodies from all sectors.

In 2020, 4 districts were selected for the implementation of the pilot programme: Barajas, Puente Vallecas, Tetuán and Villaverde.

Content of the Pilot programme:

- First round of Talks: with elite female athletes, referees and women directors of sports institutions.
- Second round of Talks: with COPLEF (Official College of Graduates in Physical Education and Physical Activity/Sports Sciences) professionals; its objective will be to publicise the different courses available at the university level, as well as the roles that can be played.
- Third round of Talks: provided by the City Council Employment Agency with the aim of guiding girls through sports for professional opportunities.
- Training workshop including the celebration of a women's Seven-a-side football tournament, with the participation of the pilot districts.

Iberdrola, Renfe and the Atlético de Madrid Foundation collaborated in the pilot programme.



Due to the situation caused by the COVID-19 pandemic, only 15 talks of the first round were completed in 9 secondary schools, with an attendance of 850 participants.

For 2021, the contents of the programme have been adapted to Covid-19, with the collaboration of Iberdrola.

5 districts have been selected: Arganzuela, Chamartín, Hortaleza, Vicálvaro and Villa de Vallecas.

Content of the 2021 programme:

- Recording of talks by Iberdrola Ambassadors that will be sent to secondary schools in the municipality of Madrid.

These talks will include the recordings submitted by the schools, with questions from students.

There will be two recordings:

One for students aged 12 to 14, whose educational objective will focus on the dreams of girls that age, in terms of sports achievements.

Another for students aged 15 to 17, focusing on the struggle to achieve one's dreams.

- Completion of 10 face-to-face clinics

2 clinics per district will be carried out in secondary schools.

- Multiple online meeting

The meeting will be carried out by connecting a classroom in each of the schools that have taken part in the Clinics with some of the female athletes who participated in the talks.

- Development of educational content with an Iberdrola ambassador to be developed in schools.

Recording of an initial content capsule of the female athlete, for the development of work content in schools (sport-specific classes, history of women's sports...)

Face-to-face talk with the Iberdrola ambassador, with representation of students from the schools that have participated in the development of the educational content.

Recording of the face-to-face talk for its dissemination among the rest of students.

Self-defence programme for women

The Madrid City Council, in collaboration with the Madrid Wrestling Federation, organises and develops the self-defence programme for women.

The activity is aimed at women aged 16 and over, and is also open to girls aged 12 to 15 accompanied by their mother or guardian.



Objectives:

- Teach women basic knowledge about protection measures, technical and self-defence skills aimed at solving real-attack scenarios.
- Increase women's self-esteem, and their quality of life, increasing the personal safety of participants.
- Publicise basic rules to increase personal safety, and that of third parties (children, sisters, mothers...), as well as their protection.
- Provide basic knowledge and solve doubts on different legal, social and police matters relating to gender violence.
- In the 2018/2019 season, 1,742 places were offered

Family-specific programmes (as an educational agent and transmitter of values)


Programme aimed at interrelating and coordinating activities for different ages, around the family unit, that complement and help balance practice and waiting times of family members in order to promote the practice of sports.

Objectives:

- Promote the joint participation of families in sports leisure activities, thus creating new alternatives.
- Contribute and provide technical support to families so that they adequately develop their role as an educational agent, transmitter of values and specialising in the socialisation and integration of boys and girls (coexistence, respect, solidarity...)
- Promote the habit of sport, thus generating healthy behaviour patterns through learning and practicing sports.
- Develop the autonomy to practice sports in leisure time.

Quantitative data:

- Quantitative offer: 1,200 places.
- Sports offer: Activities of; Parent-child swimming (adults and babies aged 1 to 4, in a pool); Parent-child physical exercise (adults with babies aged three months to 4 years, in a room); and "While You Wait" activities to help balance practice and waiting times for adults and minors, scheduling activities for companions or playroom activities...
- Period of service: September to June (sports season) or fixed duration.
- Location: Municipal Sports Centres.



Child Psycho-motor education Programme for children aged 3 to 8:


Programme aimed at promoting the general development of boys and girls through two complementary actions: direct sessions with children and regular tutoring with parents or legal guardians.

Objectives:

- Promote the personal development of each child, tending to their motor, cognitive, affective and socialisation skills, through educational actions based on movement games.
- Facilitate an initial approach and familiarisation with the environment of the sports centre and the different activities that take place in it.
- From an approach of respect for diversity, incorporate and integrate children with special educational needs in a normalised environment.

Quantitative data:

- Quantitative offer: 732 places offered with the participation of 607 boys and girls.
- Sports offer: general service and/or summer service to favour the personal development of boys and girls, tending to their motor, cognitive, affective and socialisation skills, through movement games; in addition to incorporating and integrating boys and girls with special educational needs in a normalised environment. Period of service: October to May of the school year.
- Location: Municipal sports centres.



Integration through sports

Programme for the Inclusion of People in a situation of social vulnerability


With a view to facilitating the normalised practice of sports for people who are in situations of social exclusion recognised by the District Social Services through the Social Services Centre that corresponds to them based on their address, and with the aim of extending the practice of physical activity to all people based on the criteria of equality, integration and social inclusion, there is a protocol agreed with the General Directorate for the Elderly, Social Care, Social Inclusion and Emergency Care, for the inclusion, under special conditions, in groups of the general programme of sports lessons and schools and special intensive courses, of people included in the following categories:

- Recipients of RMI (minimum income for integration) who are eligible for the social intervention programme.
- RMI (minimum income for integration) applicants pending concession by the Community of Madrid who are eligible for the social intervention programme.
- People who have been unemployed for a period of 3 years or longer
- People living on the street or in centres for the homeless under a social support programme
- Women living in facilities for Victims of Gender Violence
- People at risk of residential exclusion.
- Young people, (aged 15 to 20) at risk of an intervention process and with detected risk of social isolation.
- Adults, (aged 21 to 64) at risk of an intervention process and with detected risk of social isolation.

The organisational measures are mainly based on creating special access conditions to facilitate their integration in the practice of sports, on the one hand, in the Preferential Inscription in standardised groups of any general programme activity, up to a limited number of places; and on the other, on applying a 100% reduction on the general price of the programmes available.

Quantitative data:

- Offer: in 39 municipal sports centres from 18 districts.
- 100% price reduction in a total of 1,562 monthly payments for people at risk of social exclusion, which represent 174 fully subsidised places.
- 422 people benefiting from a price reduction at some point during the sports season (data obtained taking into account turnover rates).



Opportunities to train coaches

Completion of work experience for the Work Centre Training (WCT) professional module corresponding to the sports teacher training and animation programme

The Madrid City Council has signed agreements with education centres (public and privately owned) for the completion of work experience for the Work Centre Training (WCT) professional module corresponding to the sports teacher training and animation programme.

The purpose of these agreements is to establish a collaboration relationship between the Madrid City Council and education centres, for the development of a Work Centre Training Programme in Work Centres, aimed at students who are receiving Official Professional Training.


The extensive network of municipal sports centres of the Madrid City Council, together with the wide range of activities carried out, and the training and professionalism of sports workers at the municipal level, make up the perfect environment for the adequate training of future professionals.

Quantitative data:

- No. agreements signed: 13
- During the 2018/2019 academic year, a total of 76 students have completed teaching work experience in Municipal Sports Centres.

Promote Fair Play in the city

The Madrid City Council has established a code of good practices in the development of municipal competition, which is included in the slogan “Fair Play. Everyone Wins” so that all the people who participate in the competition, athletes, technical staff, team delegates, family members and companions, comply with the rules of the established code, which includes respect for the opponent, teamwork, acceptance of social norms, rejection of any physical or verbal violence, mediation, equal treatment and non-discrimination, concentration and effort for the benefit of the team...



06 Rates of population that practice sport

Total number of members of clubs and federations. Classification

Madrid sports federations processed 523,569 licences in 2019. Taking into account that the population of the municipality of Madrid represents 49.4% of the total of the Community of Madrid, it can be extrapolated that 258,643 licenses correspond to the municipality of Madrid.

Regarding clubs, in the Community of Madrid there were 5,794 sports bodies in 2019. The clubs based in the municipality of Madrid are estimated to have around 500,000 members, which is the result of adding to the number of licences, the approximate 241,000 members of the 4 major professional clubs (Atlético de Madrid, Real Madrid, Rayo Vallecano and Estudiantes).

Madrid, active city


Subject matter of the statistical research

This section provides information on the sports habits and practice of Spanish people aged 15 and over, on the sports equipment they have at home, on viewing sports events, either in person or through audiovisual media, and on their relationship with sports federations or bodies. Whenever possible, indicators have been broken down by the following variables:

- Gender, age group and education level
- Employment situation
- Autonomous Community

Information sources:

The main source of information used has been the 2015 Survey on Sports Habits in Spain, a statistical operation belonging to the National Statistics Plan developed by the Ministry together with the High Council for Sports. The National Statistics Institute has participated in certain aspects of the sample design for the project.


Data

According to the last two surveys on sports habits in Spain, there has been significant growth in the rate of practice of sports, higher in women and among young people.

The 2015 data estimate that 46.2% of the population over 15 years of age practice some sport on a weekly basis (50.4% of men compared to 42.1% of women), which indicates a growth of more than 9% with regard to data from 2010 (37% total participation, 45.5% men compared to 28.8% women).

Behaviour by gender explains this great evolution, given that, although the practice rate increases in both, the 13.3% increase in women is much higher than in men (4.9%).

The 15% gender gap that existed in 2010 has dropped to 8% today.




People who practice sports on a weekly basis in Spain



With regard to data of the Community of Madrid:

- 50.5% of the population practices sports on a weekly basis.
- There is an 7.6% increase with regard to the previous survey.
- By gender, 53.5% in men compared to 47.8% in women, reducing the gender gap to 5.7%, compared with results at the national level, which is 8%.

Hábitos y estilos de vida / Actividad Física (Habits and lifestyles / Physical Activity): Eduardo Pedrero Pérez, Nieves Botella Cañamares, Teresa Benítez Robredo, M.^a Carmen López Jiménez, Yolanda Quintana Moreno, Sara Morales Alonso, Agustín Haro León and Blanca Álvarez Crespo.

This study, which is more related to the habits and lifestyles of Madrid citizens, focuses on detecting the level of physical activity from a health viewpoint, looking for it indirectly through an analysis of the sedentary behaviour of the city's population.

Scientific evidence shows that moderate daily activity improves health. Regular physical activity is inversely related to the risk of cardiovascular disease, stroke, high blood pressure, type 2 diabetes, osteoporosis, obesity, colon and breast cancer, anxiety, and depression. In addition, it contributes to the development and maintenance of a healthy locomotor system. Physical activity can be carried out both at work and during free time, and therefore it is possible to compensate for a sedentary job by an increase in activity during periods of free time.

In this study, in order to be able to compare the results of the Madrid survey with those obtained at the national and European level, the same questions used in the national survey have been included.

People under 70 years are also asked about the physical activity they carry out both in their usual occupation and in their free time; they are also asked to complete the short version of the adapted International Physical Activity Questionnaire (IPAQ).

City of Madrid data

In order to obtain data on the sedentary behaviour of population, a combination of two questions have been analysed in order to detect those who do not carry out any physical activity under any circumstance:

- Physical activity during free time
- Physical activity during usual occupation
- Sedentary behaviour. No physical activity is carried out under any circumstance


Physical activity during free time:

People who to the question, ‘which of these possibilities best describes the frequency with which you do physical activity in your free time?’ respond that they do not exercise at all and are almost completely sedentary during their free time (reading, watching television, going to the cinema, etc.) are considered to practice sedentary leisure.

- 30% of those participating in the survey maintain sedentary habits in their free time.
- This data is significantly higher in women: 34%, than in men: 25.2%.
- By age, no significant differences are observed except in the population over 65 years of age who have a 1.21 times higher risk of being sedentary in their free time than the younger population.
- Sedentary behaviour during leisure time is linked to the level of education, but in this case inversely to the trend in the usual occupation: 45.5% of people with primary education or lower, 31.7% of people with secondary studies and 24% of people with university studies state that they do not carry out any type of physical activity in their free time, the risk of sedentary behaviour during leisure time being significantly higher in people with a level of primary education or lower and in those with secondary studies, compared to those with higher studies completed.
- The same occurs in relation to social class, with higher rates of people who are sedentary in their free time in lower social classes, with rates of inactivity in their free time of 38.5%, while people from upper social classes have a higher inactivity rate in their usual occupation, of 52.7%.

However, sedentary behaviour during free time in the city of Madrid has dropped significantly when compared with the results of the 2005 survey and is lower than that found in the country as a whole in the

2017 National Health Survey, which amounts to 37.8%.



Physical activity during usual occupation

People who answer that they spend most of the day sitting down are considered sedentary in this area when asked the following question: Which of these possibilities best describes your main activity at work, school, home (housework)?


- 44% refer to working in a job in which they do not carry out any physical activity.
- There are significant differences by gender, with a higher proportion of men, 49.2%, who say they are sedentary in their usual occupation, compared to women in the same situation (38.7%).
- 43.5% of the Madrid population aged 15 and over declared that they did not carry out any physical activity during their usual occupation compared to 38% of the Spanish population and 50% of the Community of Madrid.
- By age, there is greater risk of being more sedentary in the usual occupation in the population aged 15 to 44 years, at least 37% higher than in those over 64 years in the same circumstances.
- By education level, 36.4% of people with primary education or lower say they are sedentary in their usual occupation, compared to 35.8% with secondary studies and 54% with university studies.
- By social class, 52.7% of people from the upper classes, 48.4% from the middle classes and 30.3% from the lower classes declare that they are sedentary in their usual occupation; the risk of being sedentary in the middle and upper classes being twice as high than in the lower classes.
- Finally, regarding the level of development of the district of residence, 37.7% of the population of the less developed districts say they are sedentary in their usual activity, compared to 42% of the population of medium-low development districts, 47.4% of the population belonging to districts with medium-high development and 47.9% of those with greater development.

Sedentary behaviour:

no physical activity is carried out under any circumstance.

Based on the answers to the aforementioned questions, in order to see who does not carry out any physical activity under any circumstance, and placing in this category the people who declared that they do not do physical exercise either in their daily occupation or in their leisure time, we find the following:

- 15.4% of the sample population could be placed in this category.
- By gender, 14.4% of men and 16.3% of women can be considered sedentary.
- The average age of sedentary people is significantly higher $A = 52.5$ than that of the rest of the sample $M = 48.8$; and, similarly to the findings for free time, it is significantly higher in the population aged 65 years and over.



- 22.8% of people with primary studies or lower can be considered sedentary, compared to 14.2% who have completed secondary education and 14.9% of those with university studies, which represent significant differences, with a higher risk in people with primary education or lower.
- There are no differences in terms of sedentary behaviour according to the level of development of the district of residence.
- Regarding social class, there is a lower risk of sedentary behaviour in the lower classes than in the other two.
- When analysing the relationship between sedentary behaviour and weight, we find that sedentary people have an average estimated Body Mass Index (BMI) of 26.0, which is significantly higher than the rest of the sample, which obtains an average BMI = 25.0.

Initiatives to promote an increase in the practice of sports among the population

The Madrid City Council carries out various actions to promote the practice of sports, with the main goal being to promote sports and physical exercise and to encourage the acquisition of healthy habits among the people of Madrid, most notably the following initiatives:


Sports Day

Within the context of the European Week of Sport, which the EU organises every year during the second week of September, as part of a global policy aimed at increasing the level of participation in sport and physical activity in the EU, the Madrid City Council organises the Municipal Sports Day every year, with the following lines of action:

- Open Day in Municipal Sports Centres.
- Planning of special promotional activities in Municipal Sports Centres, within the framework of the European Week of Sport.
- Assignment of spaces to sports bodies for the development of special activities to promote sport within the framework of the European Week of Sport.
- Special activities to promote the practice of physical activity and sport on Sports Day.

In 2020, Sports Day was held on 27 September.

This year's edition aimed to give greater visibility to municipal sports services, claiming their central role in promoting the health and well-being of the Madrid population, and to encourage the practice of sports in a safe and healthy manner, at a time when the lockdown due to Covid-19 had raised the rates of physical inactivity alarmingly.



Activities were planned around the concept of fitness focusing on different age groups.

In addition, in view of the preventive health measures in place, an alternative 100% online plan was carried out, with live broadcasts of the scheduled physical exercise sessions, which were available to the population via streaming.

Cross-generational Municipal Sports-Leisure Day for Health: SHALL WE PLAY?

With a view to contributing to the promotion of healthy habits in a context of prevention of obesity among the child and adolescent population, this cross-generational family activity was organised, including recreational-sports activities to be shared by people of all ages.

In addition, the Madrid Health Municipal Agency collaborated in the project with activities to disseminate and promote the acquisition of healthy habits relating to physical activity, nutrition and the prevention of risk factors, such as the FINDRISC tool, healthy eating, the Walking People project.

Sports on the Street Programme

The main goal of the Sports on the Street Programme is to promote the practice of open-air sports and physical exercise for the acquisition of healthy habits, offering citizens basic knowledge so they can gain autonomy, and also promoting social relations and the occupation of leisure and free time. In addition to expanding sports services, by capitalising on the use of public space for sports activities.

At this time, the Street Sports Programme includes the following:

- Walking around Madrid
- Running through Madrid
- Cycling around Madrid
- Nordic Walking around Madrid

This programme is carried out in collaboration with Sports Federations.

Promotion of “SWEET MOBILITY”

Measures to reduce the presence of private vehicles in urban spaces. Alternative mobility

Within the future SMO (Sustainable Mobility Ordinance), in the section on environmental regulatory improvements to protect people's health and improve their quality of life in development of the “Madrid 360” Strategy, it should be noted that:

- The entire city of Madrid will be a Low Emission Zone (LEZ), with prohibited access and circulation to the most polluting vehicles.
- The category of Special Protection Low Emission Zones (SPL EZs) is created to adopt the necessary measures to prohibit or limit access, circulation, parking and speed.
- The “Centro” District is established as a Special Protection Low Emissions Zone (SPL EZ), and is subject to a very similar regulation to that currently governed by the SMO under the name “Madrid Central”.
- Increase in the dissuasive effectiveness of the SER (Regulated Parking Service) as an instrument of environmental sustainability.
- The definitive pedestrianisation of at least one street per district is being studied, proposed by the Municipal Government Council for the “Madrid 360” strategy
- Pedestrianisation of the Puerta del Sol square.

How is alternative mobility being promoted?

The future Ordinance will adopt a series of improvements in regulations to promote sustainable mobility and subsequently, an alternative to the use of private vehicles, such as:

- With regard to parking: The use of electric bicycles and scooters is encouraged due to their advantages in terms of the environment and social distancing measures for part of the population in the



“new normal”, while the problems of accessibility and abusive use of pavements arising from the use of these vehicles is solved by imposing that pavement parking is carried out exclusively at specific anchor points for these vehicles.

With regard to motorbikes: Accessibility requirements for pavement parking have been reinforced. The rotation of exclusive parking reservations is promoted by limiting the capacity that can be used by shared use motorbikes.

- The possibility that certain groups may make use of a Request Stop service on specific EMT bus lines at night (women, minors and people with reduced mobility).
- Electric Scooters (PMV) are allowed to circulate on cycle lanes (“multi-modal lanes”) using a helmet.


Measures to promote and facilitate the use of public transport and sustainable transport

It should be noted that the Government Area for Environment and Mobility is committed to the development of the Cycling Master Plan which includes the implementation of different bicycle lanes throughout the city in order to improve mobility throughout the districts of the capital.

The city of Madrid had 692 km of bicycle lanes at the end of 2019, and 958 km if two-way lanes are counted twice. 64% of this network (611.96 km) corresponds to exclusive cycling routes, in which we must highlight the 65-km Green Cycle Belt that circles the city of Madrid.

The Government Area for Environment and Mobility plans to:

- Improve cycle lane projects by capitalising on the knowledge and experience accumulated in the city over the last decade.
- Make cycling projects consistent with other sustainable mobility goals such as improving pedestrian quality and traffic calming.
- Facilitate the drafting of projects and reflection on the characteristics of cycling routes, both for the technicians responsible for them both inside and outside the City Council, as well as for political leaders and citizens.
- Adjust projects to regulatory developments such as the Mobility Ordinance, Instruction 1/2018 on the Accessibility Study that must accompany Municipal Intervention Projects on Public Space, the standardisation of construction elements or the modification of the



General Regulation on Circulation for the introduction of the 30 km/h limit on streets with single-lane traffic.

- Technically define the dual model of cycling infrastructures proposed in the 2016 Cyclist Mobility Master Plan.

The city of Madrid has 216 stations with 5,067 anchor points. And in 2019, 46 new stations and 1,077 anchor points were installed. (All within the M-30 ring road. Data as of the end of 2019)

The extension involves 50 new stations in 13 districts, 22 of them outside the M-30, the most recent station opened in Usera this month.

This is the largest expansion of the service since its launch in 2014.

The expansion of BiciMAD will be extended gradually to the rest of districts in Madrid outside the M-30.


As a novelty, the Madrid Municipal Transport Company (EMT) has deployed the 'BiciMAD Go' service in Madrid, a new shared mobility project with electric bicycles that do not have a fixed base. The EMT has been authorised by the Madrid City Council to operate a total of 454 free floating bicycles throughout the city.

Electric bicycles will be distributed in 72 points across 15 districts as follows: 46 streets of eight districts located inside the M-30 (Centro, Salamanca, Retiro, Tetuán, Chamberí, Chamartín, Arganzuela and Moncloa) and 25 areas of seven districts outside the ring road (Hortaleza, Ciudad Lineal, Moratalaz, Puente de Vallecas, Usera, Carabanchel and Latina). There will be a total of 254 vehicles located in different neighbourhoods of the city centre and 200 outside it.

The expansion of BiciMAD and BiciMAD GO will be extended gradually to the rest of districts in Madrid outside the M-30.

Information and activities to promote sustainable mobility for citizens

At present, the City Council's budget on mobility includes an item for the Promotion, Control and development of transport amounting to more than 2.5 million Euro, separate from that developed by the EMT.

Actions to boost sports tourism


At this time, there is an official alliance being agreed between Madrid Destino (a municipal company responsible for promoting the city), the Delegated Area for Tourism and the Delegated Area for Sport, so that in 2022 Madrid can be presented as a safe sports destination.

Communication plan to promote the candidacy

Communication plan to promote the candidacy

Contextualisation

In November 2019, on the occasion of a Davis Cup event, the Mayor of Madrid, José Luis Martínez - Almeida, together with the Deputy Mayor, Begoña Villacís, announced the city's candidacy for the 2022 World Capital of Sport award, granted by ACES Europe, to distinguish those cities that carry out special work for sport.

After a year of developing the new municipal sports policy, which started with the establishment of an Area dedicated to the management of sports and its facilities, and the appointment of Sofía Miranda as the Responsible Councillor, the results and the transformation obtained meet the demands and requirements that the candidacy calls for.

Since the aforementioned announcement, this Delegated Area for Sport was assigned the task of preparing the candidacy, with the understanding that Madrid has powerful arguments to qualify for this award, all of them set out in the candidacy document.

The potential achievement of this award, in addition to contributing to the prestige of the city and its municipal management, is an incentive and a stimulus for all sports groups, sports companies, clubs and for all athletes, which in itself will increase the importance of sport in Madrid society, and also contribute to the achievement of the goals and challenges proposed by the Madrid City Council for this legislative term.

In accordance with this context, this communication plan will address two key moments. The development of the actual candidacy, throughout most of 2021, up to when ACES EUROPE makes the decision in November. And in the event of achieving the award, its projection throughout the year 2022.

Communication plan objectives

Taking into account that the plan will be developed between January and November 2021 and throughout 2022, in the event of receiving the award, the plan objectives are the following:

- To publicise the candidacy as much as possible among the Madrid population and, if the award is obtained, publicise its importance after it is awarded, offering maximum transparency and proximity to make the population feel that the candidacy and the award belongs to them.
- Publicise the arguments with which the city is opting for the award, understanding that they represent the highest values and are the result of management and sports policy, and that said values correspond to and connect with the normal values of the population.
- Achieve the maximum prestige for Madrid municipal sport and for the city of Madrid as a whole.

Messages

The primary message of the candidacy is the following:

“Madrid is a city that represents the vanguard of municipal sports management given the scope and quality of the direct offer of services and activities for the population, the dynamism of its large associative and federated network, and the organisation and hosting of major international events”.

The secondary message:

“The development and consolidation of a quality sports offer guarantees better health and well-being for the entire population. The achievement of this type of award facilitates the acquisition of resources to optimise sports services and, consequently, the benefits to citizens”.

Channels

The general channels that best respond to the objectives, audiences and message will be used, within the strategy established by the actual candidacy:

- **Radio. Press. TV.**
- **Digital channels.**
- **Video and YouTube platforms.**
- **Social Media.**
- **Municipal website and blog.**
- **Video.**
- **Streaming.**
- **Internal screen circuit.**


The choice of channels will be determined by the population targets we are trying to reach: if it is young audiences, digital communication, including Social Media and visual communication actions, will be prioritised (using colloquial language, an affectionate fun tone).

When we address a more mature audience, we must choose general media, among other channels (with a more polished and explanatory language, which transmits seriousness, professionalism and warmth).

Brand Management

The candidacy constitutes a brand in itself, therefore it will include a differentiating corporate identity or logo that distinguishes it from the rest of candidate cities and that helps to associate the messages with the city of Madrid.

Building a strong brand and its wide-spread implementation are paramount.



Actions

The first key action will be the design and layout of the document used to present the candidacy.

Once the objectives, audiences, message and channels have been defined, and a differentiating corporate identity has been decided, the following actions are proposed, which correspond to corporate and commercial communication instruments:

Creation and projection of the candidacy's identity

- Creation and design of the official logo with application guide.
- Implementation of the logo in Area and MSC emails, and in all communications.
- Implementation in all media relating to sports events organised in collaboration or sponsored by the City Council during 2021.
- Implementation in the 73 Municipal Sports Centres through advertising media. (canvases in pavilions, displays in entrances...)
- Implementation in all types of information, graphic and digital media, on the offer of sports services and activities.
- Implementation in outdoor advertising media and general media.
- Implementation in other media: rear advertising, roll-ups, banners, flags, photo-call sessions, posters, and other, for use in events and activations.
- Deployment in the digital screen circuit of the MSC.

Relationships with general media

- Organisation of press conferences and presentations, on the occasion of actions and activations.
- Press statements and releases.
- Provision of photographs, videos and other resources.

Advertising and Promotion

- 3 campaigns, with a 2-week duration, of outdoor advertising (billboards and dynamic billboards) and screens in Callao square.
- Direct marketing or digital mailing to sports groups (federations, clubs...)
- 2 radio advertising campaigns, within the established media plan.
- Production of Merchandising items and their distribution.
- Coordination with Tourism media (Madrid Destino, Cultura, Turismo y Negocio, S.A.)

Activations

- Presentation of each of the actions on the occasion of the candidacy: presentation of official document; organisation of the ACES EUROPE evaluation visit, and other.
- Presentations by ambassadors joining the candidacy (athletes, bodies...).
- Inaugurations of facilities and opening of activities.
- In general, the development of the offer itself will generate activations that will serve to strengthen the candidacy.

Online Communication

In this type of communication, the availability of a video presentation and the definition of the candidacy, and any other actions that may arise, is paramount.

- Website.
- Social Media.
- YouTube videos.
- Broadcast video streaming of all candidacy activations.

Strategy and schedule

All the actions described must be carried out according to the strategy and schedule to be determined by the protocol imposed by ACES EUROPE.

From a strategic point of view, the activations will have to be intensified and selected, both in number and importance, at key moments of the candidacy.

The strategic framework will also determine the proportion and timing of digital and analogue actions, and their media.

Budget

The execution of the communication plan will require the following budget, taking into account that all the channels and resources of the Madrid City Council will be used, which will not involve any expense.

In addition, during 2020, work has been advanced, with its corresponding cost, in creating and designing candidacy identity, the layout of the official document, and the recording of the video.

Under a policy of maximum limits, the required budget for this plan would be 61,000 Euro. Obviously, this forecast is subject to increases or reductions, as determined.

Relationship between the City Council and sports/political institutions at the local, regional and national level

The Madrid City Council interacts with local, regional and national sports institutions mainly through collaboration agreements and, in some cases, sponsorship contracts to attract large sporting events.

Regarding political institutions, the City Council maintains a close relationship of collaboration and communication with the Community of Madrid; we jointly carry out a significant percentage of our major sports events. We have a close relationship with the High Council for Sports, achieving in 2021 the first agreement between the HCS and a local body for high-level athletes to train at our facilities free of charge.

In addition, Madrid is working as one of the advocate cities for a project to create a network of Spanish cities for sport.

Along with the Spanish Olympic Committee, the City Council has formed a committee to attract and promote major sports events, so that federations are able to present candidacies for major events in our city.


Agreements, relationships with local, regional and national sports organisations

The Madrid City Council, from its Delegated Area for Sport, has a Strategy to Attract Major Sports events to the city. These major events are attracted jointly with the different sports federations, with whom we are in permanent contact.


To do this, we are consolidating a committee to attract and promote large sports events, to which federations and bodies can submit major events to which they are eligible.

All major sports events must have a direct impact on grassroots sports and for this reason we have created the clause to promote grassroots sports in our sponsorship contracts for major sporting events.

This clause requests specific compensation from sports event organisers for our Madrid grassroots clubs, with the understanding that if a sports event does not impact these clubs, it cannot be considered a successful event.

Achievement of the five main objectives of the ACES Europe manifesto (enjoyment in exercise, willingness to achieve, sense of community, fair play and improvement of health)



Such health improvement must be fun, innovative, modern, adapted to new sports disciplines and must be available to everyone.

However, this does not detract from a fundamental aspect of sport, that of competition. Madrid boasts the largest grassroots sports competition in all of Europe; our sports community has been competing in our municipal sports games for 41 years.

The city is always campaigning for citizens to practice the sport of their choice, and for this we offer sports activities outdoors, in our municipal sports centres and from home through our YouTube channel.



World Capital of Sport. Social benefits


The city will benefit from an important social and economic impact.
